The Three R's

- **Reduce**

- Using less one-time use products that will end up in the landfill

- **Reuse**

- Swapping out one-time use products for glass, plastic, or fabric products that can be used more than once

- **Recycle**

- Turning your glass, plastic, paper, and cardboard waste into other useful items/materials

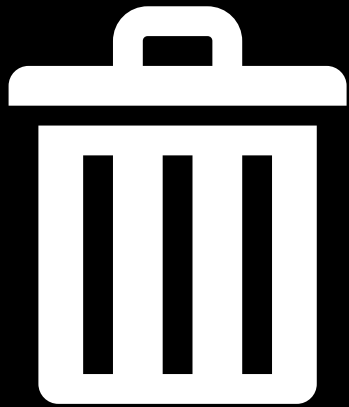


Four Rules of Recycling

1. No food, no grease, and no liquid
2. If it's plastic and you can ball it up in your hand, it's garbage
3. If it's plastic and you drink out of it, it must have a "neck" in order to be recycled
4. If it's 2 or more materials and they can't be separated, it's garbage
